Ca' Momi Enoteca and Pizzeria will always use organic, local and Italian ingredients prepared according to traditional Italian recipes, paying tribute to the owners' heritage.

“When we came to America, we knew we wanted to make wine here, and to capture some of the spirit of our family traditions,” explained Valentina Guolo-Migotto. “In Italy, wine is a part of life, and we combine it with wonderful food. At Ca' Momi we will have all kinds of authentic treats: real pizza - the classic Neapolitan style we like to make from our wood burning oven - tramezzini, crostate and crostatine di frutta, baci di dama, zaetti, tiramisu', cantucci and biscotti from the pasticceria. And of course great wines.”

The enoteca and pizzeria will feature not only Ca' Momi wines, but also a selection of wine discoveries from smaller regions and producers in Italy.

“We are happy to bring in wines from our friends around Italy, and are always looking for something different and interesting - something that we think captures the spirit of Italian life,” added Dario De Conti. “Ca' Momi Enoteca and Pizzeria is our way of bringing the real Italy straight to Napa.”

"Authentic Italian pizza and pastries are something we've been missing in the main hall, and something our market visitors will enjoy very much. I can't wait," Carlin added.

About Ca' Momi (House of Momi)

Ca' Momi wines are named for the family home in Northern Italy. The name pays tribute to Momi dea Bionda, a local character who was famous for his obsession with the house, his grapes and his wine. Momi's protective spirit is still watching over the property. In his later years he liked to ride around the property in an old motorcycle, with his blind dog sitting in the sidecar. He would patrol the vineyards, armed with a rifle, just to make sure that his grapes were safe. Ca' Momi captures the spirit of our family traditions. Of course, we are just a little bit obsessive about our wines and our food, too!

About Oxbow Public Market

Oxbow Public Market is located at 610 & 644 First Street, Napa, within the emerging Oxbow District of Napa and has become the local gathering place for great food and wine in the Napa Valley and downtown Napa. The 40,000 square foot marketplace, which includes a scenic outdoor deck with seating along the Napa River, features a diverse tenant mixture of local food vendors, artisan cafes and an organic produce outlet for local farms.

The Market is open 7 days a week and only closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day.
